## **Selling & Thinning Native Timber on Freehold Land**

**Making the most from your coloured areas by using sustainable forest practices!**

\* Sam Ellis (AgForests) will discuss and demonstrate what landholders can do regarding timber harvesting and forest practice thinning in both 'coloured' (remnant) and white (non-remnant) country, and comply with the Vegetation Management Act and Native Forest Practice Code.

- How to combine grazing and native forest timber production
  - Knowing more about timber markets and products
  - Understanding 'productive' and 'unproductive' trees
  - Protection of biodiversity, habitat, and ecological values.
  - Nationally accredited training day that can go towards the attainment of a Certificate IV in conservation and land Management.

*Michael Brodie with assistance from AgForests has used a chopper roller to mechanically thin cypress on his property at a cost of approximately \$50/ Hectare. The use of machine thinning of cypress under the code will be discussed and the site inspected.*
