**Making the most from your coloured areas by using
sustainable forest practices!**

* Sam Ellis (AgForests) will discuss and demonstrate what landholders can do regarding timber harvesting and forest practice thinning in both 'coloured' (remnant) and white (non-remnant) country, and comply with the Vegetation Management Act and Native Forest Practice Code.

 - Knowing more about timber markets and products
 - Understanding 'productive' and 'unproductive' trees
 - Protection of biodiversity, habitat, and ecological values.

Phil Donges with assistance from Agforests has used a chopper roller to mechanically thin cypress on his property at a cost of approximately \$50/ Hectare. The use of machine thinning of cypress under the code will be discussed and the site inspected.
