Foundation Vegetation Workshop Overview



AgForward Vegetation Management Workshops

The AgForward Vegetation Management Workshop provides landowners with information on the Vegetation Management legislation (tree clearing), and what can and can't be cleared without needing a permit.

What is covered in the workshop?

Each participating enterprise will receive V. 6 Regional Ecosystem map, V.2 Regrowth Map and a satellite map of their property (ies). At the workshop participants will:

- Interpret Regional Ecosystem (RE) and Regrowth maps
 - Interpreting the coloured areas
 - Interpreting the numbered codes on the RE map
 - Interpret the Regrowth Map
 - Learn how to use the Regrowth Code
 - What trees/regrowth can be cleared without needing a permit under the *Vegetation Management Act 1999*.
- Secure white areas (non-remnant vegetation) in order to clear again in the future
 - Using a process called a Property Map of Assessable Vegetation (PMAV)
- Understand the concepts of a detailed PMAV
- Interpret the exemptions under the legislation
- Understand activities that will need a vegetation clearing permit
- Gain an understanding of the Native Forest practice Code (on freehold land)
- Be introduced to technology to assist with Vegetation Management
