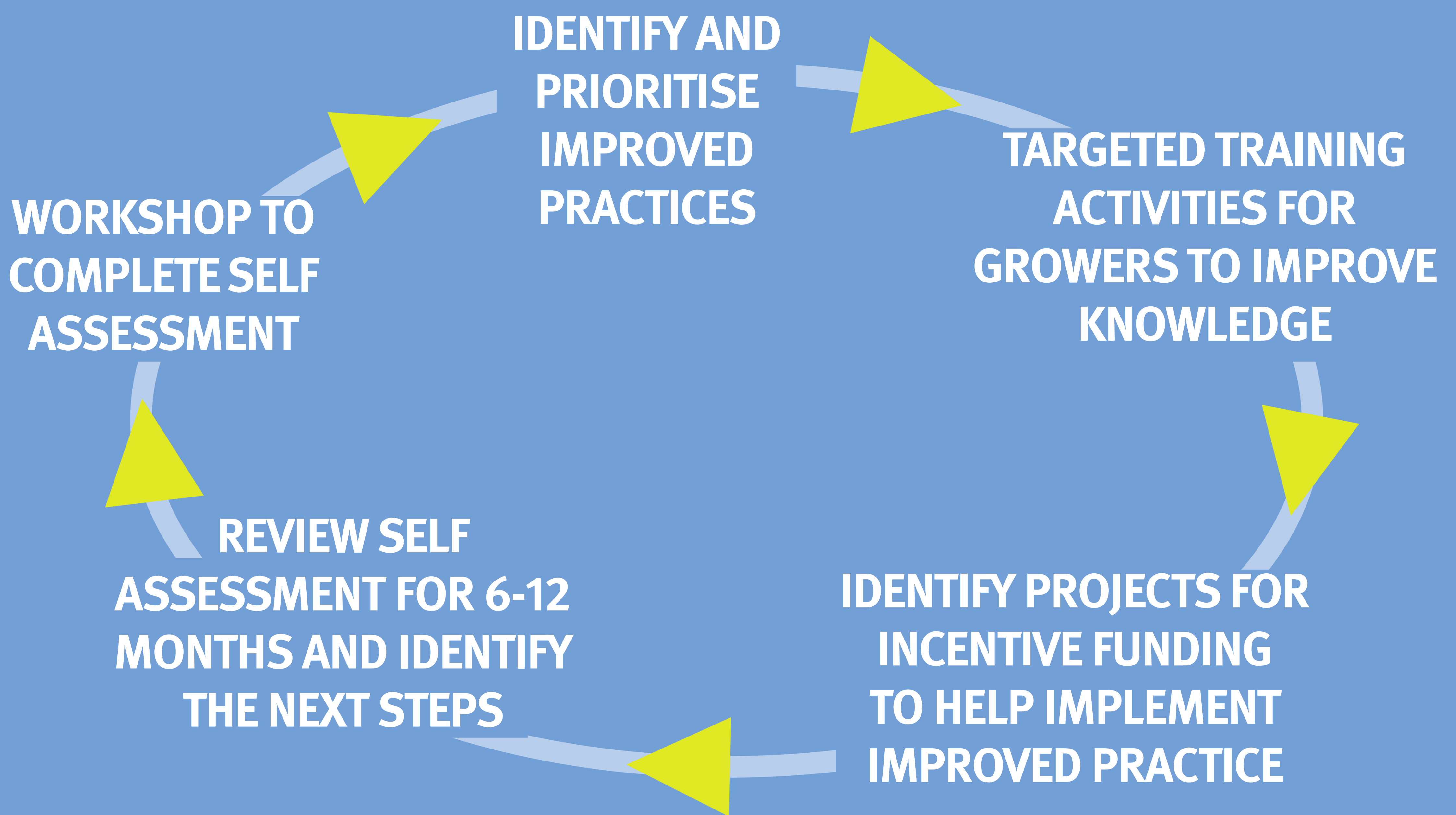


Grains BMP in central Queensland



WORKSHOP TO COMPLETE SELF ASSESSMENT:

- ▶ Growers assess their farming practices against industry standards at www.grainsbmp.com.au. Technical staff can assist growers to complete their assessments.

IDENTIFY AND PRIORITISE IMPROVED PRACTICES:

- ▶ Where self assessments identify opportunities for improvement, action plans are developed to document the steps required to implement changes.

TARGETED TRAINING ACTIVITIES FOR GROWERS TO IMPROVE KNOWLEDGE:

- ▶ Training activities on topics covered in the self assessments are run by industry experts to help growers gain knowledge to improve practices identified in action plans.

IDENTIFY PROJECTS FOR INCENTIVE FUNDING TO HELP IMPLEMENT IMPROVED PRACTICE:

- ▶ Field officers from the Fitzroy Basin Association assist growers to develop projects to improve farming practices identified in action plans and training activities. In some cases these projects may be eligible for funding assistance from the Australian government.

REVIEW SELF ASSESSMENT AFTER 6–12 MONTHS AND IDENTIFY THE NEXT STEPS:

- ▶ After implementing projects, growers are encouraged to review their self assessments and action plans previously developed.
